



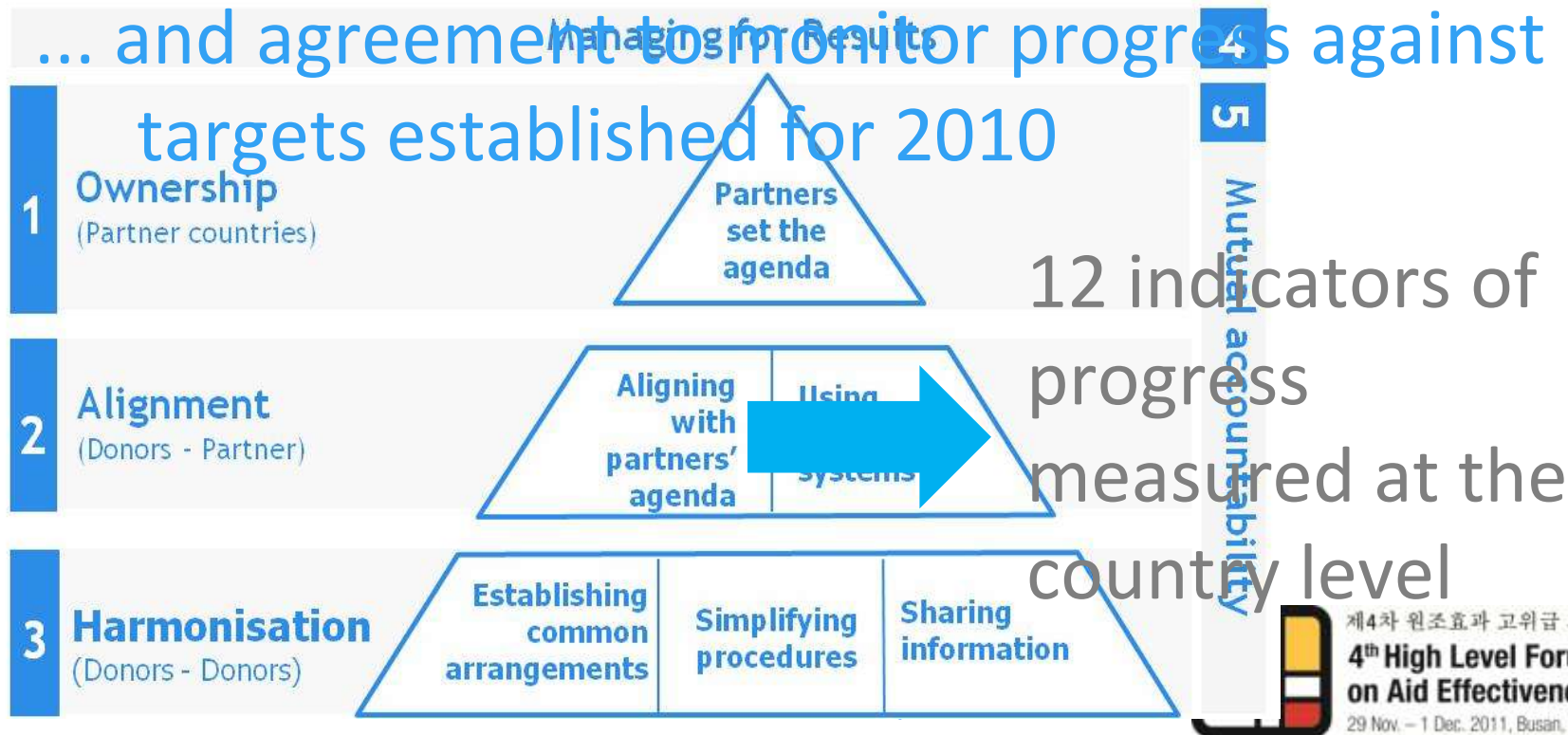

2005: Paris Declaration on Aid Effectiveness
5 principles, 56 commitments



HLF 4: an evidence-based process

- **Monitoring** the implementation of the Paris Declaration and AAA
 - Surveys (2006, 2008, 2011): 78 countries in 2011 (incl. 12 countries looking at Fragile States Principles)
 - *Have commitments been implemented?*
- **Evaluating** the Paris Declaration (independent process)
 - 22 countries and 18 donors/agencies
 - *Relevance? Efficiency? Results?*



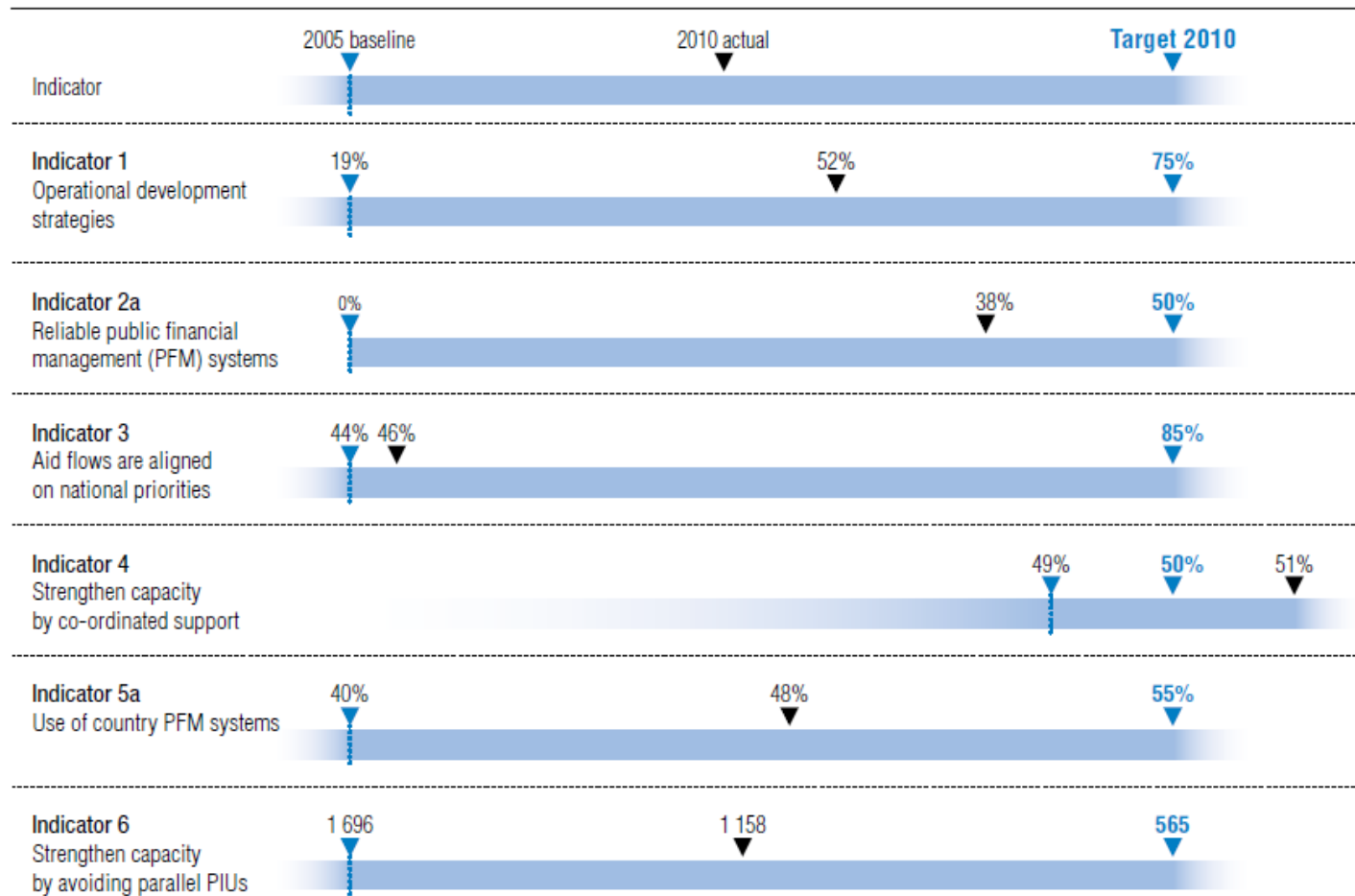
The evidence is now in: what's the verdict?

- Progress is happening in the right direction, but **too slowly** : only one target met
- **Aid effectiveness matters for development:** relevance and impact beyond aid
- **A successful international “compact” for reform** - legitimacy of norms and standards
- Need to sustain **the political momentum**
- Greater **accountability and learning** through monitoring and evaluation

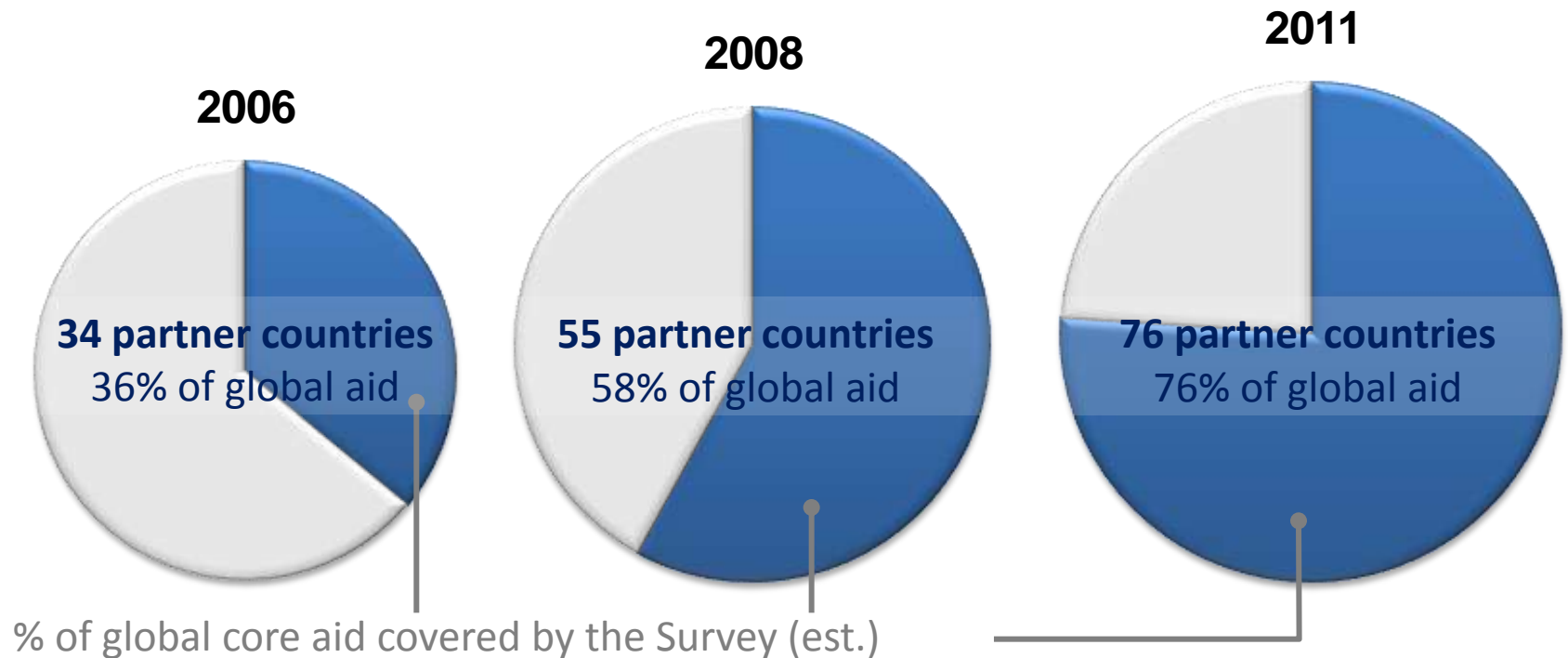
